

RIVER WILDERNESS TO GET NEW DUAL WATER SUPPLY

Bob Lindstrom, who is the HOA Chairman for Property and Infrastructure recently had the opportunity to meet with the Senior Infrastructure Inspections officer for Manatee County. Their discussion concerned the new water line being installed along Ft. Hamer Road which is planned to supply water to Parrish and the new Islands of River Wilderness community. In the discussion, Bob learned that there will be a hook up of this waterline off of Ft. Hamer Road into River Wilderness at the Creole Court emergency entrance. RW will be provided a complete hook-up to the new line which means we will now have a dual feed into the community. The dual feed will allow section isolation in the event of water line breaks in the community, allowing us to minimize water outages during repairs.

The construction should not cause any traffic concerns or major water disruptions to the RW community (or Creole Court residents) except for the very brief interruption of water service while the connection is being made. Manatee County will provide pre notification of any and all disruptions. Also, since the water line will be laid along the side of the emergency road, at least one lane of the exit will be open for emergency vehicle access during the entire construction process.

This construction is already in progress. There is currently no precise completion date, but it should be completed over the next month.
