Re: RW Security Cameras To Be Upgraded This Week

Beginning on Wednesday, October 1, 2014, Dehart Alarm Systems, Inc. will be working on our property to upgrade the Camera systems at the Old Tampa Road Gate, the Ft. Hamer Gate and the RV Lot. Dehart is scheduled to complete the job by Friday. However, this is outside work and is subject to rain delays. There should be little to no impact on gate traffic while this work is going on, but we can expect some lane impact as various camera positions are set. We would appreciate your patience if these short intervals impact your travels.

Following the upgrade to a new camera system, we will have multiple enhanced digital cameras to monitor events, break-ins, and vandalism. We will have a broad view of the situation and a digital zoom capability to see specific areas of the photo. We will be able to monitor traffic in both entry and exit lanes of both gates. We will have several viewpoints to monitor the RV Lot. The cameras will have a low light capability that enhances night recording. Expanded video storage capacity (2TB hard drives) and software will allow us to more quickly and easily recall pertinent events and to evaluate multiple viewpoints in order to clearly assess the situations.

We are installing the latest digital technology, internet protocol, infra-red day/night video capability. The cameras will deliver considerably improved picture/video quality. This is another step to improve the security of our community.
