Re: Free Oak Trees

One of the County Ordinances that the HOA enforces and manages within the RW Community is the requirement for replacing any Canopy trees that die or are cut down. County Code requires that each tree removed must be replaced by the property owner within 60 days with another "canopy tree". Further, depending on the size of the tree, county requirements specify multiple trees must be replanted. Therefore, our covenants specify that the HOA Board must provide prior architectural approval for any tree removal and replacement. In some cases, we can and will work with the resident to replace these trees elsewhere in the community. This means that the HOA has some extra trees, and we are offering them to you. We have 6-8 trees available and the HOA will plant them for you in your front yard at no cost. First come, first served. If you would like to have the HOA plant an Oak tree in your front yard, please let us know by contacting Jim Andries at 941-776-2531.
