The HOA will be changing the **flowers** around the community on Tuesday, September 6, replacing the pentas with marigolds. This means the pentas will be available for your gardens if you would like them. Our landscapers will put the pentas in the fitness center parking lot about 11:00 a.m. Please partake of these pretty purple pentas per your pleasure.

The **drainage** throughout the River Wilderness property has been stressed and tested with an abundance of rain and wind over the past week. We are pleased to note that it has held up well. We have noticed a few areas where the water could move more efficiently, but overall the drainage systems worked as designed. We do still have several areas where the ground is really soggy. We will not be mowing these areas until they have dried out a bit. We appreciate your understanding. It will take a few days to catch up. If you have remaining "standing" water in your area 24 hours after the rain has stopped, please let us know by hitting reply to this message. While it is not the season to fix these issues, it is the time to notice them.

Also, there were several **trees** that were either broken or have fallen. These have now been removed. If we have missed any common area trees near you, please let us know by hitting reply to this message.

Please remember that Labor Day Monday is an observed **holiday** in our community. Vendors will not be permitted in the community either on Sunday or Monday. Enjoy your Labor Day weekend.
