Re: Three Quick Reminders from the HOA

First, Washington Palms need to be trimmed now - prior to hurricane season. Our Property Manager noted last week that many properties in the community had Washington Palms that needed trimming. We ask that you take notice of your own trees and have all dead branches trimmed now for the safety of the neighborhood in high wind situations. The HOA will send out individual letters next month, but why not just get the job done now?

Second, there are two gates into and out of River Wilderness. During a routine cleaning of the Old Tampa Road gatehouse last weekend, we needed to provide instructions to many residents who did not know how to enter/exit the community using the Ft. Hamer gate. In the event of emergencies (necessary evacuations, blockages from downed trees, floods etc.) every resident must know both of these routes. Our RW website has a community road map that you can download (click to download map). Please take the time now to familiarize yourself with all of the community's roads and entrance gates. Your barcodes work at both entrances.

Third, Monday, May 29 is Memorial Day. It is a designated Holiday for the River Wilderness community. This means that it is a quiet day where no commercial vehicles or work is allowed in the community. Please schedule your vendor work schedules to avoid them being in our community on Memorial Day.
