Re: FEMA / Irma Debris Removal

On Monday, November 6, 2017 FEMA finally sent the HOA Registered Agent the Right of Entry paperwork to grant them access to the private roads within our community for IRMA Debris removal activities. That paperwork was signed and returned to FEMA on the same day that it was received.

On Monday, November 13, 2017, a representative from FEMA visited River Wilderness. They drove through the community to determine the amount of debris that needs to be removed.

They stated they plan on returning to River Wilderness this week to begin the debris removal.

The process is relatively simple but there are a few call-outs.

- 1) The FEMA teams will only come by your property once so it is imperative you have all the debris ready for pick-up.
- 2) The debris MUST be near the curb. There will be a truck with a tractor that will grab the debris and place it in the truck. If the debris is up on your driveway, and not along the curb, the tractor cannot reach the debris. They cannot drive up your driveway without causing possible damage. You will need to relocate this debris if you want FEMA pickup.
- 3) The process to pick up the debris will leave some remnants behind (e.g., leaves and small branches). We will all have to sweep up afterwards or your yard maintenance vendors may be willing to help clean up whatever is left over.

We do not have a date or timeframe at this moment but please start preparing your IRMA debris now, if you need to do so. This will ensure the FEMA Teams can reach it and get it removed from your property.
