2021 Projects Completed:

Pool Area – Pool planters were refreshed with new plantings from the donations collected. Weeding and trimming the pool entrance hedges; trimming blue daze; pulling weeds from planters in pool area; several major acorn/leave clean up days

Hammocks Sign – tended to flowers; replaced Geraniums with Pentas

RLR common area. – continued maintenance of the preserve area

WFD Jasmine area – several major moss/twigs/leave clean up days which included pulling moss from trees; hand weeding and blowing/sweeping the gutters

MRD fence and circle common areas –replaced Geraniums with Pentas; several major moss/twigs/leave clean-up days throughout the year

Pond 44 common area – several major moss/twigs/leaves clean-up days throughout the year

MRD/WFD outer circle common area – replaced dying flax lilies with liriopes; several major moss/twigs/leave clean up days throughout the year; fertilized and sprayed pesticide for aphids several times throughout the year.

Let us give a big thank you to our hard-working committee members for keeping our community looking beautiful!! The BC would like to thank our Board for their continued support.

2022 Future Projects:

- 1. Monitoring, pruning, replacing as needed flowers at the pool area and other common areas.
- 2. Working with the Board to refresh the dead liriopes and replace them with new ones at the WFD/MRD inner circle to keep the circle in good condition.
- 3. Keeping the common areas at the pond area and the MRD/WFD area picked up: removing fallen twigs and moss.
