Architectural Guidelines

The community of River Wilderness and the neighborhood of the Hammocks are deed restricted entities. As a result, certain standards are in place and these standards are monitored by an Architectural Review Committee (ARC). To help the homeowner navigate these standards the ARC has published a Guideline Supplement. The latest revision to this supplement is Revision 5.27.21 (pgs. 13,16,18-19) and includes the newly passed guidelines regarding overnight parking, pruning canopy trees and dog owner's policy for 'poop and scoop'.
